2021 APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

WHO CAN APPLY:

Any student who is a senior in high school or currently enrolled as an undergraduate student in an accredited post-secondary two or four year college or technical school, who is the son or daughter of a NUCARI member, or a present employee of a member company, and will be enrolling full-time in an academic institution for the year beginning September, 2021 such as an university, four-year college, two-year college, or an accredited technical school.

HOW THE APPLICATION BE JUDGED:

Selections will be based on the merit of the application. The Scholarship Committee will take the following into consideration:

- Scholastic Standing
- ACT and/or SAT Scores
- Extra-Curricular Activities
- Career Goals
- Community Service
- Written Essay

HOW THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE APPLICATION BE PROTECTED:

When the application is received by NUCARI, each application will be numbered. Once this has been done the first page of the application will be placed in a sealed envelope marked only with the number of the application. The Scholarship Committee will review the application without any knowledge of the name, address, etc. of the applicant. Once a selection has been made, only the winning envelope will be opened to identify the award recipient.

Note: We do ask your permission to use the Essays in future publications and will credit the author if your piece is used. Please initial where indicated on the application if you are authorizing the use of your work.

WHAT MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION:

1. A transcript of grades through the latest period ending prior to May 30, 2021
2. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the school you are currently enrolled in. The letter should include the number of students in the graduating class and class standing of the applicant (if applicable).
3. Additional recommendations from people familiar with the applicant's ability and character, and from responsible members of the community (optional but recommended).
4. Please indicate the NUCARI company by which you and/or your parent is employed.
